RULES

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ATTIRE

All persons using the Club Facilities are expected to dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere of the Club and in a manner consistent with the specific dress policies and rules published by the Club for particular areas and activities. Members are responsible for advising their guests as to appropriate dress.

Shirts and shoes shall be worn at all times on the Club premises, except in pool areas and locker rooms. No bathing suits are permitted outside of pool areas and locker rooms unless covered with appropriate attire.

Pub Dining- Casual Attire meaning dress jeans and dress shorts, collared shirts, no hats, tee shirts, or flip flops.

Dining Room- Dressy Casual: Collared Shirts, Dress Shoes, No tee shirts, shorts, jeans, hats or flip flops

Front Veranda – Shirts & Shoes required

For special evening dining, appropriate dress will be announced in the notifications.

Please be courteous in brushing off your shoes with the equipment provided prior to entering the Club House. Metal spikes are prohibited.

Definitions:

Casual Attire – No hats or tee-shirts, dress jeans and shorts permitted

Dressy Casual – No hats, No jeans, No shorts, Collared Shirts

Jackets Required – Suit or Sport Jacket, Tie optional

Semi-Formal – Suit & Tie

Black Tie – Dark suit and Tie or Tux required

Generally, The Orchard House is currently “Casual Attire” at all times.

When anything other than “Casual Attire” is required notification will be made through the Newsletter, via e-mail, and noted on invitations where applicable.

This is your Club. Please feel comfortable to dress as you like, keeping these minimum requirements in mind.
