

The Reserve at Lake Keowee Community Foundation Artist in Residence Program

Location: Hwy 133 in Sunset, SC. The Reserve at Lake Keowee is located on the shores of Lake Keowee and in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. The Reserve has over 650 property owners and can also draw participation from the surrounding area.

Eligibility: Visual Arts, Literature, Music, Performing Arts, Architecture, Design, Dance. Artists are selected by committee review of the artist's proposal and work.

Work Environment: Access to the Foundation office/gallery. Exhibition/installation space. Also artist will have access to various sites on the property. It is the hope that the residency can provide an opportunity for interaction between the artist and the community.

Housing/Meals/Other Facilities & Services: Furnished cottage or Guest House room provided for the artist stay and partner, lunch and dinner each day at Orchard House provided for artist and partner (non-alcoholic beverages only); Access to pool, hiking, kayaking, tennis, and golf. Travel expenses will be reimbursed up to \$1000 and a weekly stipend of \$500 will be offered to cover other expenses. Accommodations are currently limited to 2 (Artist and partner). *If children accompany artist, additional costs to be paid by artist. No accommodations for pets are available on site.*

Residency Statistics:

Resident Season: Flexible

Length of Residence: Up to 1 week

Number of Residencies available: Up to 2 per year

Artist responsible for: Materials and equipment, food and beverage, other than those specified, personal transportation, and personal expenses. Additionally he/she must acknowledge The Reserve at Lake Keowee Community Foundation in any publicity material related to time spent at The Reserve.

expectations & opportunities: The Foundation will assist with transportation costs of work to be exhibited in gallery. Each artist in residence is expected to be available for at least one interaction with

Reserve property owners and invited general public, as well as open to creating a piece to be contributed to the Foundation (if applicable) to be added to the Foundation's permanent collection. Donated work must be received no later than one year after an artist's residency.

Artist must be willing to invite the community to experience the creation of his/her artwork. This may involve regular studio visiting hours, a scheduled lecture or workshop or some other forum that the artist is comfortable with.

Proposal Requirement: Please send an artist statement, email and phone number, project proposal including projected costs, along with a current resume, at least 3 professional references, and a CD with 10 digital images or musical equivalent of recent work to:
